Exit Feedback B.A.(R.S.) Final Year students
Report - 2018-19

The college conducted the exit feedback from B.A.(R.S.) final year students for the session 2018-19. Total 42 students participated in exit feedback. The structured questionnaire was developed on important aspects of the work done by the college. Questionnaire included 9 questions with multiple choices and the last question was open ended question on students suggestions. The tabulated data has been analyzed and discussed as follows:

1) Curriculum of B.A.(R.S.) Programme

As per the opinion of 97.62% students, the curriculum of rural service was far better than the curriculum of the arts stream, while only 2.38% student remarked that it was similar like other curriculum. None of the students stated it was of lower category.

2) Teaching Method

When the students were asked about their opinion on the teaching method, there was an incredible response from the students. 95.24% stated it as excellent, while 4.76% rated it as average. It shows that teachers are taking great efforts in teaching.

3) Project report work

Preparing the project report is the special feature of the curriculum of B.A.Rural Services. 66.67% students stated that the social research method has been effective and imparted them affluent knowledge. The remaining 33.33% students rated it as average. Hence, students get research oriented knowledge in the areas of rural economics, cooperation and rural sociology.

4) Internal assessment structure/ pattern

The internal assessment work done by the teachers was effective and impartial as per the majority(83.33%) of students stated in their responses. While 16.67% students stated that some changes required for improvement of internal assessment.

5) Other activities:

Majority (88.10%) of the students stated that college conducts various regular activities through NSS Camp, Sports, Cultural & other Programmes other than teaching as excellent/outstanding, while 11.90% responded that it was average.

6) Library facilities:

The students were asked to give their opinion on the library facility in the college. Majority (90.48%)of the students stated it was excellent, while 7.14% students replied that it was average, only 2.38% stated it was below average.

7) Sports facility:

As per the opinion of 73.81% students, the sports facility in the college was ample/adequate, where as 26.19% students opined as facilities available were just average.

8) Administrative work:

While answering to the question about the work proceedings in the office, 76.16% students stated that it was efficient and earnest, while 21.43% rated it as average. Only 2.38% student commented that the work proceeding was unsatisfactory.

9) Other facilities:

In total 83.33% students expressed their views about the college building and other facilities as excellent. Only 16.67% expressed about the facilities as average.


10) The students gave some suggestions for the future development of the college. The response from the students are as mentioned below:


Based on the academic growth of the college, some suggestions were given to initiate PG courses in Political science (16.67%), History (19.04%), Geography (2.38%), and Psychology (2.38%) as optional subjects. Similarly the students suggested about establishing post graduate courses like MSW (35.71%), MA. Economics (9.52), MA English (14.28%), Further they also urged to start English speaking classes (14.28%), skill based training class like mushroom production (7.14%), Computer hardware courses (2.38%), Diploma/Training courses based on job/employment (4.76%), and also to avail job opportunities (11.90%). Along with it (52.38%) students suggested about initiating a college canteen, Internet facility to be regularized (7.14%), provision of free Wifi for the students (4.76%), Recess to be extended by half an hour (for eating lunch) 9.52%, a spacious washroom for the girls (7.14%), a separate arrangement should be made for eating lunch (2.38%), arrangement of dustbin in each classroom (2.38), to permit students to make their own choices of selecting songs/dance performances while participating in cultural programme (Yuva- rang) (11.90%). The students also proposed about starting a training program in Small Scale Industries.

Good opinion:


- 1) As per the opinion of the students, the curriculum of BA rural services is excellent/good.
- 2) The classrooms and the other facilities in the college are good.
- 3) The students benefited and gained much knowledge from the subject of community development and extension.
- 4) By means of the special NSS camp organized by the college, the students have got the opportunity to develop confidence and stage daring.
