

Feedback from Parents (2018-19) Report

The institution has Parents feedback mechanism and for the academic session, 2018-19 feedback from the parents of BA rural services students was obtained. The feedback-form consists of 11 questions based on why the parents choose the college for their wards, what they discuss with their wards about the institution, how often they visited the institution, their expectations from the institution, their observations regarding overall environment in the college and their views about various departments and services provided to the students.

Question number 1, 2, 4, 5, 6, 8 and 11 are multiple choice questions and for question number 1, 5 and 6 the parents can choose one or more than one option is for the questions. Question number 3, 7, 9 and 10 were of descriptive type and the parents were expected to write their views and suggestions. In all total 57 parents gave their feedback about the institution.

Question wise responses of the parents were as follows:

1. In response to the question why parents selected the institution for their wards the parents responded that they selected the institution because:
 - a) the institution was vicinity - 3.50%
 - b) the institution provides education - 100 %
 - c) the institution offers the curriculum of students interest-10.52%
 - d) the institution has good facilities -7%

2. The parents' response to the question how often they ask their wards about college education when they get back home.
 - a) regularly – 59.89%
 - b) sometimes – 42.10%
 - c) never – 1.75%

3. When asked about what the parents discuss with their wards about the college after getting back from the college. According to the parents they generally discuss the following things with their wards:
 - a) about studies
 - b) topics taught
 - c) what happened in the college
 - d) activities organised by the college
 - e) teachers' teaching
 - f) regularity of the classes
 - g) about education
 - h) about sports activities

4. Parents' visit to the institution to know about the educational development of their wards -

According to 46.61% parents they visited the institution only once, according to 12.28% parents they visited twice, 12.28% parents visited many times, whereas 31.57% parents responded that they never visited the institution to know about the educational development of their wards.

6. Parents' expectation about their wards career. Parents' responses to this question were as follows:

7. In response to the question what are your expectations from the institution for the overall development of your ward, the parents' responses can be broadly categorised in the following points:

- d) different skill oriented programs should be organised
- e) efforts should be taken for personality development and self esteem
- f) bus facility for boys and girls
- g) good facilities and support services for the students
- h) time to time guidance by the teachers

Five parents (8.77%) didn't respond to this question.



In response to the question regarding the parents' and their wards' satisfaction about the educational environment and other facilities in the college, the parents responded that 96.14% of them are completely satisfied, 5.26% are partially satisfied. No one responded as 'not satisfied' and 'cannot say'
9. Parents' opinion about the institution -
- Overall environment in the institution - almost all parents responded that the atmosphere in the college is very good and helpful for the development of the students.
 - College Teaching Staff – according to the parents the teaching staff is very good, excellent and cooperative.
 - College Administration- according to the parents the college administration is very good and well managed.
 - College Library – according to the parents the college library is very good and enriched, it has peaceful atmosphere and very convenient for the students.
 - Games and Sports Department – according to the parents games and sports Department of the college is very good and supportive.

Three parents (2.56%) didn't respond to this question
