

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Report - Student Satisfaction Survey (2018-19)

The College conducted a Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS) regarding teaching-learning and evaluation under Criterion II in 2018-19. For SSS the questionnaire prepared by NAAC was used. In this survey total 36 students participated from BA (RS) Part I & II (21+15). The students responded to the questions. The questionnaire has total 20 questions regarding teaching-learning and evaluation, every question has five responses and a student has to choose any one response for each question with her/his sincere effort and thought. Question-wise responses of the students' are as follows:

- 1. The syllabus covered in the class:**
According to 86.11% students, 85 to 100% syllabus was covered in the class; 11.11% students responded that 70 to 84% syllabus was covered; only one student (2.78%) responded that 52 to 69% syllabus was covered.
- 2. The teachers preparation for the classes:**
According to 80.56% students the teachers prepared *thoroughly* for the class, 16.67% students responded that teachers prepared *satisfactorily*, only one student (2.78%) responded that the teachers prepared *indifferently* for the class.
- 3. The teachers ability to communicate:**
According to 86.11% students the teachers communication was *always effective*, for 11.11% students it was *sometimes effective*, only one student (2.78%) responded that the teachers' communication was *just satisfactorily*
- 4. The teacher's approach to teaching :** according to 52.77% students the teachers approach to teaching can be best described as *excellent* whereas for 41.67% students it was *very good* and for 5.56% students it was *good*
- 5. Fairness of internal evaluation process by the teachers:** According to 75% students the fairness of internal evaluation process by the teachers was *always fair*, for 8.33% students it was *usually fair* whereas 16.67% students responded that it was *sometimes unfair*
- 6. Discussing Students' Performance in Assessment with the students:** according to 75% students the performance in assignments was discussed *every time*, according to 22.22% students it was discussed *usually*, only one student (2.78%) responded that it was discussed *occasionally/sometimes*
- 7. The institute's initiatives in promoting internship, student exchange, field visit opportunities for students:** according to 88.89% students the institute *regularly* takes interest in promoting such opportunities for students, according to 8.33% students and the response was *often*, only one student (2.78%) responded that it was *sometimes*
- 8. The teaching and mentoring process facilitates in cognitive, social and emotional growth :** according to 63.89% students teaching and monitoring process in the college *significantly* facilitates in their cognitive, social and emotional growth, according to 36.11% students it facilitates *very well*.
- 9. The institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow:** 69.44% students responded to this as *strongly agree*, whereas 30.56% students responded as *agree*.
- 10. Teachers inform students about students' expected competencies, course outcomes and program outcomes:** according to 75% students and teachers inform them *every*

time about their expected competencies, course outcomes and program outcomes, according to 22.22% students the teachers inform them *usually* about the same, only one student (2.78%) responded that the teachers informed him *occasionally/sometimes*.

11. **Necessary follow-up by mentor with an assigned task:** according to 61.11% students their mentor does the necessary follow-up with an assigned task to them *every time*, according to 36.11% students their mentor does follow up *usually*, only one student (2.78%) responded that the teachers informed him *occasionally/sometimes*.
12. **The teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications:** according to 86.11% students the teachers *every time* illustrate the concepts through examples and applications, according to 13.89% students the response was *usually*.
13. **The teacher identifies student strengths and encourage them providing right level of challenges:** according to 63.89% students the teachers *fully* identified their strengths and encourage them providing right level of challenges, according to 33.33% students and teachers act *reasonably*, only one student (2.78%) responded to this as '*slightly*'
14. **Teachers identify students weaknesses and help to overcome them:** according to 72.22% students the teachers were able to identify the weaknesses and help them to overcome it *every time*, according to 25% students the response was *usually*, only one student (2.78%) responded as *rarely*
15. **Institution's efforts to engage students in monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching-learning process:** 55.56% students were strongly agree to this statement, 38.89% students were agree, 2.78% students were neutral, and 2.78% students were disagree with this statement
16. **The institute/ teachers use student centric methods, such as experiential learning, participative learning and problem solving methodologies for enhancing learning experiences.**
According to 66.66% students and teachers use student centric methods to a *great extent*, according to 27.78% students the teachers use student centric methods in *moderate* way, for one student (2.78%) the teachers *somewhat use* student centric methods and for one student (2.78%) the teachers use *very little* use student centric methods
17. **The teachers encourage the students to participate in extracurricular activities:** 66.66% students *strongly agree* with the statement that the teachers are encouraged the students to participate in extracurricular activities, 30.56% students *agree* to the statement whereas 2.78% students are *neutral* about it.
18. **Efforts made by the institute/ teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make the students ready for the world of work.**
According to 72.22% students the institute/teachers take efforts to a *great extent*, according to 19.44% students the institute/teachers take *moderate* efforts whereas according to 8.33% students the response was *some what*
19. **Percentage of teachers using ICT:** according to 41.67% students *above 90%* teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, multimedia etc. while teaching; according to 33.32% students *70-89%* teachers use ICT tools; according to 16.67% students *50-69%* teachers use ICT tools and according to 8.33% students the percentage of teachers using ICT tools was *below 29%*
20. **The overall quality of teaching-learning process in the institution is very good:** the response of 77.78% students to this statement was *strongly agree*, whereas 22.22% students responded as *agree*.
