Analysis Report of Students' Feedback (2018-19)

B.A (R.S.) Part I/II/III

The institution has students feedback mechanism. The feedback was obtained in 2018-19 of B.A.(Rural Services)-I, II and III year students. Total 131 students (46, 43 and 42 students from B.A.(R.S.) Part-I, Part-II and Part-III, respectively) participated in Student Feedback activity. The structured feedback questionnaire was developed with close and open ended type of questions. Total 25 questions were framed on different aspects such as teaching-learning process, scheduled classes, course curriculum, students' confidence, students' motivation, internal assessment mechanism, field-visit and field survey and suggestions for college development. The feedback questionnaire was of five point scale. question No. 1 to 22 were for all students, whereas question No. 23 was for B.A.(R.S.) Part-II and B.A.(R.S.) Part-III year students and question No. 24 was only for B.A.(R.S.) Part-III year students. The last question was open ended questions, the students were asked for their suggestions for college development. The statement-wise analysis and discussion of the feedback is as follows:

1. **Periods** -In response to a question whether teachers engage the scheduled lecture on time 85.50% students are strongly agree, 14.50% students are agree whereas no student responded as 'not sure' or 'disagree' or 'strongly disagree'.
2. **Teachers' Attire** – Students' responses to the question regarding teachers' attire and cleanliness are - 87.02% students are strongly agree. 12.21% students are agree, only one student (0.77%)is not sure about it, no student responded to the question as 'disagree' or 'strongly disagree'.
3. **Teachers Voice** - when asked about whether teachers voice is sufficient for the classroom teaching 65.65% student responded as strongly agree, 32.06 % students are agree, three students (2.29%) are not sure about it and , no student responded to the question as 'disagree' or 'strongly disagree'.
4. **Blackboard Writing** -In response to the question regarding clarity of teachers' blackboard writing 80.92% students responded strongly agree, 18.32% students are agree, only one student (0.76%)is not sure about it. No student responded to the question as 'disagree' or 'strongly disagree'.
5. **Reference book** - When asked, Do teachers suggest reference books for further study? - 74.81% students are strongly agree, 24.93% students are agree and one student (0.76%)is not sure about it. No student responded to the question as 'disagree' or 'strongly disagree'.
6. **Teachers' Confidence** - In Response to the Question regarding whether teachers teach with confidence 80.16% students are strongly agree, 19.08% students are agree and only one student (0.76%)is not sure about it. No student responded to the question as 'disagree' or 'strongly disagree'.

7. **Student Motivation-** in response to the question, whether teachers motivate the students to ask questions, 74.05% students are strongly agree and 25.95% students are agree. No student responded as, 'not sure' or 'disagree' or 'strongly disagree'.
8. **Participation of Teachers** - In response to the question whether teachers participate in activities other than academics - 64.12% students responded as strongly agree, 31.30% students are agree and six students (4.58%) are not sure about this. No student responded to the question as 'disagree' or 'strongly disagree'.
9. **Completion of syllabus** - In response to the question regarding completion of syllabus in time by teachers 78.63% students are strongly agree and 21.37% students are agree. No student responded as, 'not sure' or 'disagree' or 'strongly disagree'.
10. **Regular class** - When asked about whether teachers conducted classes regularly as per schedule, 85.50% students are strongly agree and 14.50% students are agree to the fact that teachers conducted classes regularly. No student responded as, 'not sure' or 'disagree' or 'strongly disagree'.
11. **Teachers' language** -When asked about whether teachers use easy to understand language with clarity of concept, 71.75% students responded that they are strongly agree and 28.25% students are agree to it. No student responded as, 'not sure' or 'disagree' or 'strongly disagree'.
12. **Use of ICT** - In response to the question regarding use of ICT in teaching-learning process, 40.46% students are strongly agree that teachers use ICT, 57.25% students are agree about it, and three students (2.29%) are not sure about it. No student responded to the question as 'disagree' or 'strongly disagree'.
13. **Extra time** - When asked whether teachers are ready to spare extra time apart from scheduled classes, 66.42% students responded as strongly agree, 32.82% students responded as agree and only one student (0.76%) is not sure about it. No student responded to the question as 'disagree' or 'strongly disagree'.
14. **Internal Assessment Work** - In response to the question regarding transparency and effectiveness of institutions internal assessment mechanism 49.62% student are strongly agree, 48.09% students are agree and three students (2.29%) expressed that they are not sure about it. No student responded to the question as 'disagree' or 'strongly disagree'.
15. **Appreciation** - When asked whether the teachers appreciate the students' efforts and praise them according, 60.31% students expressed that they are strongly agree, 37.40% students are agree to it and three students (2.29%) expressed that they are not sure about it. No student responded to the question as 'disagree' or 'strongly disagree'.
16. **Availability of infrastructural facilities** - In response to the question regarding college building, classrooms and other facilities 73.28% students are strongly agree with it, 25.69% students responded as 'agree' and only one student (0.76%) is not sure about it. No student responded to the question as 'disagree' or 'strongly disagree'.

17. **Motivation for Personality Development** - When asked whether teachers motivate the students to participate in the programs and activities related to personality development 73.28% students responded as strongly agree, 26.72% students responded as agree. No student responded as, 'not sure' or 'disagree' or 'strongly disagree'.
18. **Mentorship scheme** - when asked whether teachers identify students weaknesses and take efforts to support students to minimise it, 56.49% students are strongly agree to it and 43.51% students are agree to it. No student responded to the question as, 'not sure' or 'disagree' or 'strongly disagree'.
19. **Opportunities** - When asked whether teachers, with their subject knowledge and skills, give information about further opportunities in their concerned subject; 67.18% students responded as strongly agree, 32.06% students responded as agree and only one student (0.76%) is not sure about it. No student responded to the question as 'disagree' or 'strongly disagree'.
20. **Teachers' social responsibility** - When asked about student's observation regarding teachers fulfilling their social responsibility, 49.62% students are strongly agree to it, 49.62% students are agree to it and only one student (0.76%) is not sure about it. No student responded to the question as 'disagree' or 'strongly disagree'.
21. **Teaching** - When asked about students responses regarding teachers teaching skills, 76.35% students are strongly agree to it, 23.65% students are agree and only few students are not sure about it. No student responded to the question as 'disagree' or 'strongly disagree'.
22. **B.A. (Rural Services)** - While responding to question whether the B.A. (Rural Services) course is different from other courses, 82.44% students are strongly agree, 17.56% students are agree about it. No student responded to the question as, 'not sure' or 'disagree' or 'strongly disagree'.
23. **Field visit and survey** - In response to whether students get the experiential learning through field visit and survey, 82.35% students are strongly agree, 17.65% students are agree. No student responded as, 'not sure' or 'disagree' or 'strongly disagree'.
24. **Project report** - When asked whether the students get the knowledge of the research methodology while working on Project Report for Economics, Sociology and Cooperation, 85.71% students responded as strongly agree whereas 14.29% students are agree. No student responded as, 'not sure' or 'disagree' or 'strongly disagree'.
25. **Students' suggestions** - In the last part of feedback, the students were asked to give their suggestions if they are unsatisfied to any of above-mentioned points or their suggestions for future development of the college.

The students' suggestions and observations are as follows:

- The classrooms should have with projectors and should be ICT enabled. (19.08%)
- The college should provide bus facility. (0.76%)
- Recess /lunch break is not sufficient; it should be of 30 minutes. (9.16%)

- To visit villages for survey and field visit the college should provide bus facility (0.77%)
- English speaking classes (10.68%)
- Additional washrooms and toilets (1.52%)
- One additional washroom for girls (3.05%)
- The college should have canteen facility for students. (6.87%)
- The college should have PG courses (2.29%)
- The college should start MSW course. (9.16%)
- There should be employment and self-employment training programs. (3.05%)
- Start classes for competitive exam.(2.29%)
- The college should have a garden. (1.52%)
- The college should provide Internet facility/Wi-Fi facility. (10.68%)
- Classrooms should be cleaned regularly. (0.76%)
- The buses do not stop at bus- stop near the college. (0.76%)
- Emphasis on personality development. (0.76%)
- The college should have a medical kit. (0.76%)
- The college should start Agro-based training courses. The courses suggested are as follows:
  - Vermicompost (2.29%)
  - Mushroom Production (3.05%)
  - Beekeeping (1.52%)
  - Kitchen Garden (0.76%)
  - Sericulture (1.52%)
  - Good Farming (0.76%)
  - Agriculture Input and Marketing (3.81%)
